1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME

4. CHAIRMAN'S REVIEW

The Chairman reported that it had been a busy year.

Meetings:

- He and CW had attended the Landfill Liaison meetings and Roxby Parish Councillors had also been invited to a site visit in July 2017, which they had found very informative.
- He and CH also attended the North Lincolnshire Council Liaison meetings.
- Roxby PC had rejoined ERNLLCA in 2016 and Roxby PC representatives attended their NL District meetings.
- SS attended the NATS meetings which were chaired by Councillor HMC.

Updates:

- The roads were still to be redone but no dates had been given.
- The 30mph speed limit sign on Brackenholmes Lane had not been moved nearer to the village sign as yet because the whole road was due to be assessed.
- The speed limit on the road between Winterton Showground and Ermine Street had been changed to 50mph.
- Roxby PC were looking at producing a Community Emergency Plan.
- In accordance with new Data Protection Laws the PC will have to appoint a Data Protection Officer this year but no guidelines had been issued as yet.
- The Chairman informed the meeting about the possible purchase of the church hall and his talk with Rev. H Croft about what might happen. Discussion took place. TJ had been looking at possible sources of funding and whether there were any grants available. NLC had earmarked funding in the budget for 2018-2019.
- The Chairman thanked the clerk and councillors for all their hard work. He also acknowledged the support received from Councillors IG and HMC.

5. LANDFILL SITE

There had been less problems with smells over the last year. At the site visit in July 2017 councillors had been impressed with the way it was run. There was no household waste going in only inert waste. There was approximately another 10 years left in the site. Eventually it would become a country park.

8. PARKING ON GRASS VERGES

Parking on grass verges had been an issue with a few residents. North Lincs Council were bringing in a scheme to issue fixed penalties to anyone found parking on the grass verges. There was no fixed date as yet for the implementation of the scheme.

9. VILLAGE IMAGE

- i) The Parish Council had issued it's first newsletter in April. The chairman asked for feedback. Barbara Abbey said she was impressed. It was decided to produce one each year.
- ii) Discussion took place about entering the best kept village competition. It was difficult to find someone who was willing to look after planters and hanging baskets. To be considered again in the future.
- iii) JJ had done a litter pick in the past and collected 7 bags of rubbish around the village.

10. OPEN FORUM

Peter Abbey brought up the subject of the road surface on North Street. The Chairman informed him that North Lincs Council were aware of the problems and the work was due to be redone. The problem had been caused by doing the work at the wrong time of the year. The chairman asked about the increased number of large lorries coming down North Street as they must be over the weight limit. It was thought they were agricultural lorries. He asked PA if he could find out the name of the company and to let the clerk know so that she could write to NLC to report them.

PA thanked the Parish Council for the work they do for and on behalf of the community.
