### MINUTES OF ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON 9 JUNE 2021 AT 7.15 PM IN THE METHODIST CHAPEL SCHOOLROOM

#### 1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

#### 2. TO RESOLVE THE MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD 11 MARCH 2020

The clerk read the minutes from the previous annual parish meeting. The minutes were accepted as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

#### 3. CHAIRMAN'S REVIEW

The Chairman read out his report. Topics included:

- flooding at the duck pond, Brackenholmes Lane, the Water Meadow and Old Hall Lane. Improvement works were carried out to the culvert at the duck pond in November 2020. Councillor Waltham arranged a Modelling Survey of the water course running from the Duck Pond to Cringlebeck. This would hopefully highlight any problem areas in order to formulate a plan of action.
- Dog fouling, littering and fly tipping continue.
- Damage to the bus shelter.
- Two local companies Biffa and Nisa had donated money to purchase a bench for Dragonby village
- The Remembrance Day service went ahead in November. Socially distancing rules were observed and the service was well attended.
- Some of the Councillors had given up their spare time to carry out quite a few jobs in the village, one being tidying up the corner of West Street and A1077.
- The playground was under review and it was hoped to obtain some new equipment for the park.
- The parish council was looking at setting up a Facebook page.
- The Chairman acknowledged and thanked D Farmery for carrying out various general maintenance jobs in the villages; Simon Hind, the clock winder and K Barley, the playground supervisor who retired in 2020 and the clerk.
