- The playground was under review and it was hoped to obtain some new equipment which would appeal to everyone.
- Two Parish Councillors regularly attended meetings with Biffa.
- Purchase of the Methodist Chapel was nearing completion.

- Also, a Parish Council Facebook group had recently been created and the parish council would be posting on there soon.
